### **Synopsis:**

Mucogingival problems are deviations from the normal anatomic relationship between the gingival margin and the mucogingival junction (MGJ). Common mucogingival conditions include gingival recession, absence or reduction of keratinized tissue, and probing depths extending beyond the MGJ. Some patients who suffer from gingival recession require intervention. Mucogingival therapy may be necessary to prevent further recession, correct cosmetic defects and eliminate root sensitivity.

This lecture presentation will highlight the clinical diagnosis and the therapeutic goals of mucogingival therapy as well as the treatment considerations in mucogingival procedures, the different surgical techniques available for mucogingival problems, and which techniques are indicated in specific clinical situations.
