SYNOPSIS

Non surgical periodontal therapy: Current status and future trends

Periodontal therapy is aimed at arresting the gingival inflammation thus preventing further periodontal breakdown.

Cause related therapy is the centerpiece of any periodontal treatment, while other surgical and non-surgical treatments are designed to complement such therapy.

In the past 25 years, a variety of antimicrobial, antiseptics, antibiotics and anti-inflammatory agents have been introduced to complement this treatment. Both systemic and local administration of these medications has been proven beneficial in reducing gingival inflammation and periodontal pockets.

The presentation currently used medications and upcoming technologies. The results of recently completed study where repeated use of LDS resulted in a significant improvement in gingival health will be revealed.

Curriculum Vitae

Eli E. Machtei

Prof. Machtei is currently the head of the Rambam HCC School of graduate dentistry and chairman of the department of Periodontology.

He has earned his DMD degree from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem and certificate of postgraduate training in periodontology from Boston University. He served for over a decade as a senior faculty in the department of periodontology at Hadassah School of Dental Medicine in Jerusalem before moving to the department of Oral Biology at the State University of New York at Buffalo where he conducted several large scale epidemiological and treatment studies at the PDCRC. He later moved to Haifa to establish and head the school of graduate dentistry of the RHCC and the Technion-I.I.T. faculty of Medicine.

Prof Machtei has published 120 papers in peer review journals in addition to over 150 abstracts. For his publications he won the Earl Robinson award of the AAP and the Ana Halprin award of the ISOMS.
